HORSE EVENTS – CONDITIONS of ENTRY

SATURDAY GATE ENTRY: ADULTS (Competitors) \$7.00, CHILDREN (5-15yrs) \$3.00

SUNDAY GATE ENTRY: \$2

Class Entry:-\$ 5.00. Prize Money: - 1st \$10.00, 2nd \$5.00, 3rd Ribbon only.

Ribbons will be presented to all placegetters (1, 2 & 3) of each class that a competition is held.

If there are no more than 2 competitors in a class, only first prize money will be paid.

Judges may combine or split any classes as they see fit but will not disadvantage any entrant.

GATES OPEN at 5.30 A.M.

NOMINATIONS START at 6.30 A.M.

ALL RINGS START at 8 A.M.

Competitors MUST complete & sign an INDEMNITY FORM prior to entering any ring. NOTE: one per rider per day's competition is required regardless of the number of classes entered.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All competitors ride at their own risk. No responsibility will be accepted for any damage or injury to any person or horse, or any loss or damage or injury to anything whatsoever
2. Junior riders (under 18) must wear approved safety helmet at all times while mounted within the perimeter of the Showgrounds (head protection AS/NZ 3838). Ask about the headgear.
3. All stallions must be led with a bit/chain and an adequately strong headstall by a person 18 years & over.
4. All Horses and Ponies entered in breed classes must be registered with their relevant Breed Society
5. No person may converse with a Judge, except when receiving instructions from that Judge, without the permission of the Ring Steward. Any person who harasses a Judge or Steward, will be removed from the grounds and any rewards forfeited
6. No verbal protests will be accepted. Any written protest must be accompanied by a deposit of \$100.00 to receive attention, and must be lodged with the Administration/Nominations Steward within 15 minutes of the completion of the event. In the event of the protest being disallowed by the Committee, the deposit will be forfeited
7. It is the competitors' responsibility to check the rings and to be on time for their classes.
8. No refunds. Programs and Judges are subject to change without notice.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Competitors **should not** exhibit before a judge with whom they are associated in any way, whether as students or associated through any financial or family arrangement.
2. Pony Hacks are not to exceed 14 hands and are to be ridden by a Junior Rider aged 17 years or under, **unless otherwise specified in the program.**
3. Galloway Hacks are to be over 14 hands and not exceeding 15 hands.
4. Hacks are to be over 15 hands.
5. Horses **may** be required to be measured on the day.
6. A Maiden is a horse that has not won first prize **three times** at an Affiliated Show. After such time the horse will be recognised as a Novice.
7. A Novice is a horse that has not won an Open Championship as a hack at any Agricultural Show or a first prize at any Royal Show prior to the day.
8. Pleasure Hack classes are to be ridden in a plain Snaffle Bridle (no drop nosebands). Spurs, whips and canes are not permitted.
9. Stallions are not permitted to be ridden in hack classes. (Breed classes excepted).
10. Junior Riders 17 years and under are to ride in short (Jodhpur) boots.
11. Local Hack is defined as 15km radius and District Hack as 30 km radius of Greenbank Showgrounds.
12. There are no stabling facilities on the grounds and all horses are to leave the grounds by 7.00pm.
13. A person must not administer a prohibited substance or cause one to be administered to an exhibit
14. Any act of cruelty will result in disqualification from the Show

Entries to be lodged on the day of the event at the Horse Administration Office (the shelter at the southern end of the Horse Rings) with the Nominations Steward and staff. Nominations will be accepted from 6.30am on the day and competitors are to have lodged their nominations at least 30 minutes prior to the commencement of their Class judging.

INDEMNITY FORMS are available at the Horse Administration/Nominations Office.

Entry to the Showgrounds for all Rings is via the Teviot Road North gate - ONLY. Parking for horse floats & trucks as directed in the designated parking area. Trucks must advise of support vehicle attending..

Due to limited parking in horse area support vehicles are to deliver show requirements then must park outside the grounds.
